

Guidelines for ESL Students

Recommendations

- Use an electronic translation dictionary or hardcopy dictionary during lecture & exams
- Maintain a vocabulary workbook.

- Participate in study groups that include native

- Prepare for class by completing assigned readings and review questions at the end of each chapter.
- Review NCLEX style questions frequently.
- Utilize Camden County College's writing lab for written assignments.
- Consult with faculty if you are having difficulty understanding course materials/assignments.
- Manage your time effectively so that you have adequate uninterrupted time to study.
